Definitions:

- Explore – to learn about unknown places or things



Reading

102 that Cheerios and crackers feel rough and hard. Sam can feed himself!
116 Sam knows that applesauce is cold and can be eaten with a spoon. Mashed
132 potatoes and oatmeal are warm and stick well to a spoon. Sam has watched his mom
149 and brother eat with forks and spoons. Sam feels like a big boy when he uses his
154 spoon. He can feed himself!
167 Sam's mom knows that toddlers learn by doing. They grow and develop by
182 exploring and trying new things. Sam has learned to feed himself. He is ready to
199 learn more! Sam's mom wants Sam to be a bright and healthy boy. She lets him do
213 as many things as he can for himself, as long as he is safe.
