Computer Instruction Information

1. Students wishing computer instruction need to be referred by a WorkForce counselor, unless they are already enrolled in ESL, CNA, or some other class offered at ABE.
2. Show up at the beginning of the class you chose. You will be given a registration form to complete and there will be some testing to see what level you are at and where you should begin. You will only have to do this once. You do not have to do it for every class you attend.
3. A lot of the information you will be working with is on-line. This means that after you are registered and tested, the instructor will determine what level you are at and where you should start. You will then be given access to the on-line programs you will be using. At this point you may decide to work at home or where ever you have computer access or continue to come to the ABE office and use our computers during the class times available. You will be working at your own pace and where you are comfortable. But you will always have the option of coming here to work with the instructor.
