

Ways to Make a Presentation!

Informal with no computer at hand

1. Print up a few of the half sheets (double summary) and hand them out to each person
2. Have one or two of our MAGR flyers with you to share (found at the library)
3. Tell them about our project and our goal
4. Ask your people to contribute together and then deposit it in your group name at Bremer Bank (Pass around a container and they can put in checks made out to MAGR, or cash)
5. OR ask your people to go to the website and make a contribution (citing your group name!)

Informal with a Computer

1. Print up a few of the half sheets (double summary) and hand them out to everyone
2. Have a number of our MAGR flyers with you to share (found at the library)
3. Go to the website **www.southwestabe.org**. There you can follow the links and choose to watch a video (two are homegrown featuring Somali Marshall community members, and the third one is a short documentary). Or you can choose to use the PowerPoint (which is easy to follow)
4. Ask your people to contribute together and then deposit it in your group name at Bremer Bank (Pass around a container and they can put in checks or cash)
5. OR ask your people to go to the website and make a contribution (citing your group name!)

Formal with Computer and Projection

It is desirable to have a Somali community member on hand to answer questions. Write to the following in a group email and give them the time and location of your presentation. Their role is to represent their community, be a show of unity, and answer questions. Ask them to respond to your invitation. One person would suffice; but more is great too!

1. **FIRST:** Contact the group you want to address to determine location, date, and time
2. **SECOND:** Send an email to Somali friends listed above and give them that information
3. **THIRD:** Print up a enough of the half sheets (double summary) so all in group can have one
4. **FOURTH:** Go to the **www.southwestabe.org** website and read through the PowerPoint attachment.
5. **FIFTH:** Preview the videos at the website, and choose which ones you want to share (two are homegrown featuring Somali Marshall community members and the third one is a short documentary)
6. **SIXTH:** GO TO THE LIBRARY
 - a. Pick up a number of our MAGR flyers so there will be enough for two to a copy
 - b. Find one of three tri-fold posters to take with you (return to library when finished)
7. **SEVENTH:** Present!
8. **EIGHTH:** Ask the group to contribute together and then deposit it in their group name at Bremer Bank (Pass around a container and they can put in checks made out to MAGR, or cash) OR ask this group's members to go to the website and make a contribution (citing their group name!).
